

# Doggie Puff Toy



## Materials

- Scissors
- Fleece
- Heavy-duty yarn or twine



## Directions

This toy is super-easy to make, so it's a nice project for kids. It's also a great way to use small, leftover pieces of fleece that may otherwise end up in a landfill.

After making a few, store them in a resealable bag or airtight container with a handful of dog treats for a few days. They will take on a bit of the smell, making them even more enticing for your pup!

**1** – First, cut your leftover fleece into strips measuring approximately ½-inch by 4 inches. You'll need about 30 strips. You can make a larger puff by making the strips longer and creating a few more of them

**2** – Stack them up in a pile and tie heavy-duty yarn or twine around the center of the entire pile. Pull it very tight, wrap it around a few more times and pull very tight again, before securing with a knot. Cut off the ends of the yarn, leaving only 1/2" in length.

**3** – Pull the various strips in different directions, forming a ball.
