

# Knitting Pattern:

## Round Spiral Blanket

### MATERIALS

**Yarn:** Worsted weight (4ply)

**Needles:** Size 9 double-pointed needles (set of 5)  
and 29-inch circular needle

**Other:** Stitch markers; tapestry needle

### PATTERN NOTES

Change to circular needle when there are too many stitches to fit comfortably on double-pointed needles. Make blanket as large or as small as needed. To close up the hole in the center, thread the cast-on tail into a tapestry needle and weave it underneath each cast-on loop. Pull tight and then down through very center and weave end into the back.

### BLANKET

With dpns, cast on 8 sts. Pm and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist.

**Rnd 1:** Knit.

**Rnd 2:** Yo, k1, \*pm, yo, k1; rep from \* to end of rnd - 16 sts.

**Rnd 3:** Knit.

**Rnd 4:** \* Slip marker, yo, knit to next marker; rep from \* to end of rnd - 24 sts.

Rep Rnds 3 & 4 until desired size ending with Rnd 4.

### Garner St. Border

**Rnd 1:** Purl.

**Rnd 2:** same as Rnd 4.

**Rnd 3:** Purl.

**Rnd 4:** same as Rnd 4.

**Rnd 5:** Purl.

**Rnd 6:** same as Rnd 4.

**Rnd 7:** Purl.

**Rnd 8:** same as Rnd 4.

**Rnd 9:** Purl.

**Rnd 10:** cast-off in knit.

### FINISHING

Weave in ends.
