

## Seashell Stitch



**Getting Started!** I suggest using 4-ply yarn and a “K” sized hook for best results.

**Chain 58**

**Row 1** – 4 DC in sixth CH from hook, \* skip next 3 CHs, 4 DC in next CH, repeat from \* across to last 3 CHs, DC in last CH.

**Row 2** – CH 1, turn, SC in each DC across, SC in top of beginning CH.

**Row 3** – CH 3 (count this as first DC, now and for the rest of the pattern), turn, 2 DC in first SC, \* skip next 3 SC, 4 DC in next SC, repeat from \* across to last 5 SC, 3DC in last SC.

**Row 4** – CH 1, turn, SC in each DC across, SC in top of beginning CH.

**Row 5** – CH 3, turn, skip next 2 SC, 4 DC in next SC, \* skip next 3 SC, 4 DC in next SC, repeat from \* across to last 3 SC, DC in last SC.

**Repeat Rows 2 – 5** for rest of piece until it is square.

**Edging** - Edge with HDC crochet, putting 3 stitches into each corner.

**Key:**

CH- Chain

DC – Double crochet

SC – Single crochet

HDC – Half double crochet
