

Teardrops



Getting Started! I suggest using 4-ply yarn and a “K” sized hook for best results.

Chain 52

Row 1 – SC in second CH from hook, * CH 1, skip next CH, SC in next CH, repeat from * across to end.

Row 2 – CH 3, work “group” in next CH 1 space (group= Yarn over, insert hook into CH 1 space and pull up a loop, YO and draw through 2 loops on hook. Do this three times, then YO and draw through all 4 loops on hook to create a “group”). * CH 1, work “group” in next CH 1 space, repeat from * across to the end, DC in last SC.

Row 3 – CH 1, SC in first DC, CH 1, * SC in next CH 1 space (between the “groups”), CH 1, repeat from * across to the top of the final CH.

Row 4 + all subsequent rows – Repeat rows 2 and 3 to make the pattern until piece is roughly square.

Edging - Edge with HDC crochet, putting 3 HDC into each corner.

Key:

SS – Slip stitch

SC – Single crochet

YO – Yarn over

DC – Double crochet

CH – Chain

HDC – Half double crochet
