

Cushy Slip Stitch Blanket



Thank you to Suzanne from Noblesville, IN for creating this knitting pattern for us. She loves that it creates a very cushy, very squishy blanket. That's our favorite kind for shelter pets!

Supplies Needed: Size 13 knitting needles, 2 skeins of Red Heart jumbo (or approximately 1,400 yards). Finished size is 21" x 32".

To begin: Hold 2 strands of yarn together and cast on 98 stitches (10 of these stitches make up the blanket's border).

Border rows 1-10: Knit across.

Slip Stitch Pattern instructions: Worked in a multiple of 3 + 1 stitches.

Row 1: Knit 5 border stitches (slip 1 wyib, k2, repeat across until last 6 stitches slip 1 wyib) K5 border stitches.

Row 2: K5 border stitches (slip 1 wyif, p2, repeat across until last 6 stitches slip 1 wyif) K5 border stitches).

Row 3: K5 border stitches (K1, slip 2 wyif repeat across until last 6 stitches, K1) K5 border stitches.

Row 4: K5 border stitches (purl across until last 5 stitches) K5 border stitches
Repeat pattern 22 times.

Ending border rows: Knit 10 rows, cast off, and weave in ends.
