

# Poppy Crossover



**Getting Started!** I suggest using 2 strands of 4-ply yarn and a “N” sized hook for best results.

## Chain 44

**Row 1** – 2 DC in 4<sup>th</sup> CH from hook, \*skip next CH, 2 DC in next CH. Repeat from \* to last two CH, skip next CH, 1 DC into last CH.

**Row 2 - 6** – CH3, \* 2 DC in the space between 2 DC group, repeat from \* across to end, put 1 DC into top of last CH3.

**Row 7 & 8** – Join new color (*for row 7 only*), CH 2, HDC in each stitch across to the end.

**Row 9** - Join original color, 2 DC in 4<sup>th</sup> CH from hook, \*skip next CH, 2 DC in next CH. Repeat from \* to last two CH, skip next CH, 1 DC into last CH.

**Row 10 - 14** - CH3, \*skip next CH, 2 DC in the space between 2 DC group, repeat from \* across to end, put 1 DC into top of last CH3.

**Row 15 & 16** – Repeat rows 7 & 8.

**Row 17 – 22** – Repeat rows 9 – 14.

**Edging** – This blanket ended up being a great size at 20” x 22”, so I just put a SC all around the perimeter, putting 3 SC into each corner.

## Key:

CH – Chain

DC – Double crochet

HDC – Half double crochet



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
