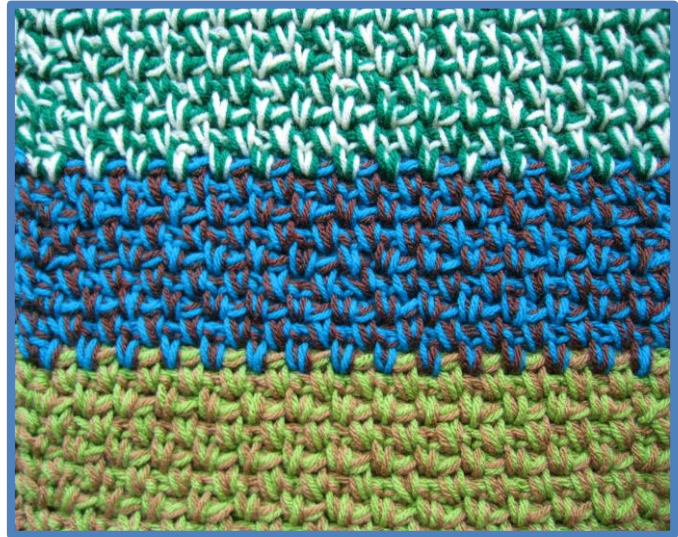


Anita's Weave*



Supplies Needed: Crochet hook size L or M and two skeins of washable yarn.

Note from Anita: *She likes to use two strands of yarn at a time, to create thick blankets rather quickly! She says the key to mastering this easy pattern is to make sure every other row has two single crochets at the beginning and end. Also, be sure that all the in-between stitches are into the chain spaces.*

To begin - CH 62 (or any even number of stitches), turn.

Row 1 – SC in second CH from hook, *CH 1, skip a stitch, SC in next stitch*. Repeat between * to the end of the row. End with a SC in the last stitch. CH 1, turn.

Row 2 – SC,* SC, CH 1 *, repeat between * across to end of row. All SC should go into space between chains. The final two stitches should both be SC (resulting in two SC at both ends). CH 1, turn.

Row 3 – SC in first stitch, * CH 1, skip over the SC below in row 2, place SC into space *, repeat between * across to end of row. All stitches go into the CH spaces. End with a SC. CH 1, turn.

Repeat – Alternate rows 2 and 3 until you reach the desired length. All “Row 2s” will have 2 SCs at beginning and end of row. All “Row 3s” will have 1 SC at beginning and end of row. All other SC are done into the CH spaces.

Border – Any type of border can be applied to this piece, from a simple SC to something more elaborate. Be sure to put three stitches into every corner as you create the border!

Key:

CH – chain

SC – single crochet
