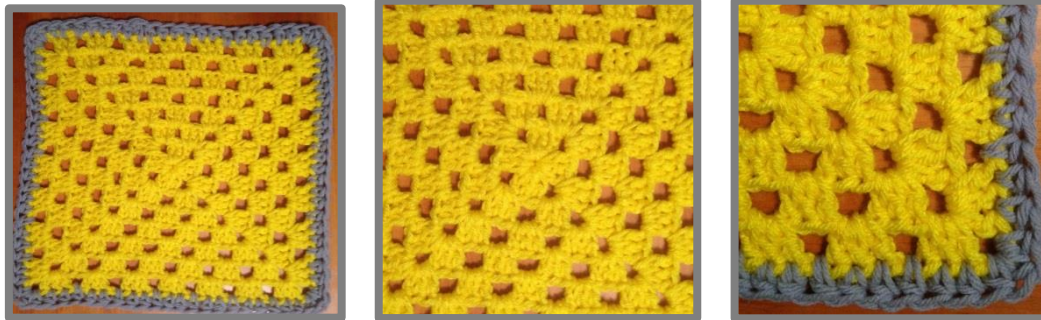


Classic Granny



Getting Started! I suggest using 4-ply yarn and a “K” sized hook for best results.

Chain 4 – Join with SS to form a ring.

Row 1 – CH3 (counts as first DC in this pattern), 2 DC into ring, CH2, (3 DC into ring, CH2)*, repeat * three times. Join with SS to first DC.

Row 2 – SS in next 2 DC and in first CH2 space, CH 3, (2 DC, CH2, 3 DC) in same space, CH1, * (3 DC, CH2, 2 DC) in next CH2 space, CH1. Repeat from * all the way around, join with SS to first DC. Row should consist of 4 “groups”.

Row 3 – SS in next 2 DC and in first CH2 space, CH3, (2 DC, CH2, 3DC) in same space, CH1, 3 DC in next CH1 space, CH1, * work “group” in next “group” (CH2 space), CH1, 3 DC in next CH1 space, CH1. Repeat from *all the way around and join with a SS to first DC.

Row 4 + all subsequent rows – SS in next 2 DC and in first CH2 space, CH3, (2 DC, CH2, 3 DC), in same space, CH1, (3 DC in next CH1 space, CH1) across to next “group”, * work group in next group, CH1, (3 DC in next CH1 space, CH1), across to next group. Repeat from * all the way around and join with SS to first DC.

Edging - Edge with HDC crochet, putting 3 HDC into each corner.

Key:

SS – Slip stitch

CH – Chain

DC – Double crochet

HDC – Half double crochet

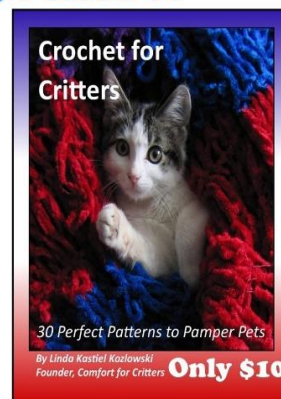
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
